### From the Desk of Father Andrew St. Hilaire

We can take many angles with the parable found within this weekend's Gospel. One of those angles is the emphasis that the kingdom grows of its own power. The kingdom is not something that we ultimately create, make, or even do. We can help spread the kingdom, but it has its origins in God and in God's activity. God is the author of the kingdom, It is his power that will make it grow and spread throughout the world.

With my time as your parochial vicar coming to a close (officially ending on Monday June 21st), this gospel passage serves as great comfort and consolation for me.

Admittedly, it took me a second look at the parable to find it comforting. The truth is that I find saying goodbye difficult. Preparing to leave these close, daily relationships feels like ripping a plant out of the soil, and the roots that were so interwoven with the ground are now exposed.

The comfort and consolation of this parable in the gospel is that we all will continue to flourish if we remain grounded in the rich soil of Christ's love. Relationships rooted in faith, like the kingdom, are ultimately God's work. God is the source of these relationships. God is the source of our community. If we remain grounded in the love of Christ, no changes in life including goodbyes - can keep us from flourishing as members of the kingdom.

May we always stay rooted in the rich soil of Christ, so that our life of prayer and faith may never wither, but grow over time. We can then more deeply appreciate the growth within our soul, the growth of the kingdom, as truly the work of God.

In His Love, Fr. Andrew Podemos analizar de muchas formas la parábola que se encuentra en el Evangelio de este fin de semana. Una de esas formas es el énfasis en que el reino crece por su propio poder. El reino no es algo que nosotros creamos, hacemos o ejecutamos. Podemos ayudar a difundir el reino, pero tiene su origen en Dios y en la actividad de Dios. Dios es el autor del reino, es su poder el que lo hará crecer y extenderse por todo el mundo.

Ya que mi tiempo como su vicario parroquial está llegando a su fin (terminando oficialmente el lunes 21 de junio), este pasaje del evangelio me sirve como un gran consuelo y alivio.

Tengo que admitir que me tomó una segunda mirada a la parábola para encontrarla reconfortante. La verdad es que me cuesta trabajo despedirme. Prepararse para dejar estas estrechas relaciones diarias se siente como arrancar una planta del suelo, y las raíces que estaban tan entretejidas con el suelo ahora están expuestas.

El consuelo y alivio de esta parábola del evangelio es que todos continuaremos floreciendo si permanecemos arraigados en la tierra fértil del amor de Cristo. Las relaciones arraigadas en la fe, como el reino, son en última instancia obra de Dios. Dios es la fuente de estas relaciones. Dios es la fuente de nuestra comunidad. Si permanecemos cimentados en el amor de Cristo, ningún cambio en la vida, incluidas las despedidas, puede impedir que sigamos creciendo como miembros del reino.

Que siempre estemos arraigados en la tierra fértil de Cristo, para que nuestra vida de oración y fe nunca se marchite, sino que crezca con el tiempo. Entonces podremos apreciar más profundamente el crecimiento dentro de nuestra alma, el crecimiento del reino, como verdaderamente obra de Dios.


