From the desk of Father Kelley

Dear Families and Friends of St. Francis Xavier Parish,

"For God did not give us a spirit of cowardice, but rather of power and love and self-control."

These words in our second reading, from Saint Paul's second letter to Saint Timothy, bring out some points worth reflecting on.

As fallen human beings, largely focused on the material world, we have a distorted understanding of power. We equate power with strength. We think of Superman or Captain America. Or Conan the Barbarian, or El Cid. Certainly they would win for peace and justice, defeating those who scheme to do evil to the good and innocent people of the land. These heroes were certainly not cowards!

Ronald Reagan had called Mother Teresa the most powerful woman in the world, when she was recognized for her work and awarded a Nobel Peace Prize. Mother Teresa? Powerful?

Absolutely. Not that she was beyond having her critics, but she had a far greater kind of power. I recently heard a motivational speaker say that by the end of her life, Mother Teresa had lost her faith and hated her life. This shows how true power, the otherworldly power of divine love, is so misunderstood by our world. Teresa's writing, released after her death, show how deep her mystical life was, to have been a 55-year dark night of the soul, absent any sense of the consolations of God, and yet she remained faithful to His will throughout her life. She had made an arrangement with God that she would detest even the smallest inclination of her will that was not in perfect union with the divine will, and that she would be, as perfectly as she could, a pencil in His hand, to suffer for and with the lowliest of His suffering people. To tend to the least of those in poverty-ridden Calcutta, by uniting herself to their nothingness, and showing them their dignity of being children in His divine love. Her religious order continues the charism of her life, continuing to show God's love to those dying in poverty. Not by fixing their dying, or their poverty, which was beyond their ability, but to do what was within their ability: to bring the light and grace of God's love into the final days of their lives.

Mother Teresa's rare character, life, and integrity, gained attention. She used whatever platform she was invited to for speaking about humility, service, and respect for the least among us, and the dignity and nature of human life. And her words had great power in their simplicity, because the testimony of her life gave power to her words. No doubt it was against constant temptation, for her and her nuns, to continue to live in such abject poverty, as well as to spend their lives tending to the disease-ridden, often disgustingly wounded, neglected people who were their life's work. The determination, the self-control, and a purified love could be the only force keeping them there, overcoming the cowardice, or the pride, that would flee. Real strength, real power, is in the power of divine love. It doesn't look like a muscle-bound superhero. It looks like the shame of being crucified. It looks like the lowliness of cleaning infected wounds in the slums. It looks like jeopardizing your reputation to defend what is good and true against the apparent good and truth championed by society. It looks like witnessing to those around you, without cowardice, but with love and self-control in your words and actions.

Desde el escritorio del Padre Kelley

Queridas familias y amigos/as de la Parroquia St Francis Xavier,

"Porque el Señor no nos ha dado un espíritu de temor, sino de fortaleza, de amor y de moderación."

Estas palabras de nuestra segunda lectura, de la segunda carta de san Pablo a san Timoteo, tienen algunos puntos sobre los que vale la pena reflexionar.

Como seres humanos caídos, centrados en gran medida en el mundo material, tenemos una comprensión distorsionada del poder. Igualamos el poder con la fuerza. Pensamos en Superman o Capitán América, o Conan el Bárbaro, o El Cid. Ciertamente ellos lucharían por la paz y la justicia ganando a los que traman hacer mal a la gente buena e inocente de la tierra. ¡Estos héroes ciertamente no son cobardes!

Ronald Reagan dijo que la Madre Teresa era la mujer más poderosa del mundo cuando fue reconocida por su trabajo y recibió el Premio Nobel de la Paz. ¿Madre Teresa? ¿Poderosa?

Absolutamente. No es que no tuviera críticos, pero tenía un tipo de poder mucho mayor. Recientemente escuché a un orador motivacional decir que al final de su vida, la Madre Teresa había perdido la fe y odiaba su vida. Esto muestra cómo el verdadero poder, el poder sobrenatural del amor divino, es tan mal entendido por nuestro mundo. Los escritos de Teresa, publicados después de su muerte, muestran cuán profunda fue su vida mística, que fue una noche oscura del alma de 55 años, sin ningún sentido del consuelo de Dios y, sin embargo, permaneció fiel a su voluntad durante toda su vida. Ella había hecho un arreglo con Dios de que detestaría hasta la más pequeña inclinación de su voluntad que no estuviera en perfecta unión con la voluntad divina, y que sería, tan perfectamente como pudiera, un lápiz en Su mano, para sufrir por y con los más humildes de Su pueblo sufriente. Para atender a los más pobres de los pobres que viven en la Calcuta plagada de pobreza, uniéndose a su nada y mostrándoles su dignidad de ser hijos en Su divino amor. Su orden religiosa continúa el carisma de su vida, continúa mostrando el amor de Dios a los que mueren en la pobreza. No arreglando su muerte o su pobreza, que está más allá de su capacidad, sino haciendo lo que está dentro de su capacidad: llevar la luz y la gracia del amor de Dios a los últimos días de sus vidas.

El carácter, la vida y la integridad excepcionales de la Madre Teresa llamaron la atención. Ella usó cualquier plataforma a la que fuera invitada para hablar sobre la humildad, el servicio y el respeto por los más pobres de los pobres entre nosotros, y la dignidad y la naturaleza de la vida humana. Y sus palabras tenían gran poder en su sencillez, porque el testimonio de su vida daba poder a sus palabras.

Sin duda, estaba en contra de la tentación constante, para ella y sus monjas, de continuar viviendo en una pobreza tan despreciable, así como de pasar sus vidas atendiendo a las personas abandonadas, plagadas de enfermedades, a menudo asquerosamente heridas, que eran el trabajo de su vida. La determinación, el autocontrol y un amor purificado podrían ser la única fuerza que las mantuviera allí, venciendo la cobardía, o el orgullo, que harían que huyeran.

La verdadera fuerza, el verdadero poder, está en el poder del amor divino. No se parece a un superhéroe musculoso. Se parece a la vergüenza de ser crucificado. Se parece a la bajeza de limpiar heridas infectadas en los barrios bajos. Se parece a poner en peligro tu reputación al defender lo que es bueno y verdadero contra el bien y la verdad aparentes defendidos por la sociedad. Se parece a dar testimonio a los que te rodean, sin cobardía, pero con amor y dominio propio en tus palabras y acciones.


