## How you can save a vocation

Vocations have seen an uptick since 2000. Yet many vocations continue to be derailed or deferred due to educational debt. The average candidate to religious life owes \$33,000 in student loans—a financial burden many religious communities cannot bear.

The National Fund for Catholic Religious Vocations was founded to address the obstacle of educational debt to religious vocations. In 2016, NFCRV partnered with NCCW to establish the Vocation Purse Club to help support NFCRV's efforts to increase vocations by alleviating the problem of education debt. To date the NCCW Vocation purse has provided more than \$50,000 to help young sisters and nuns.
