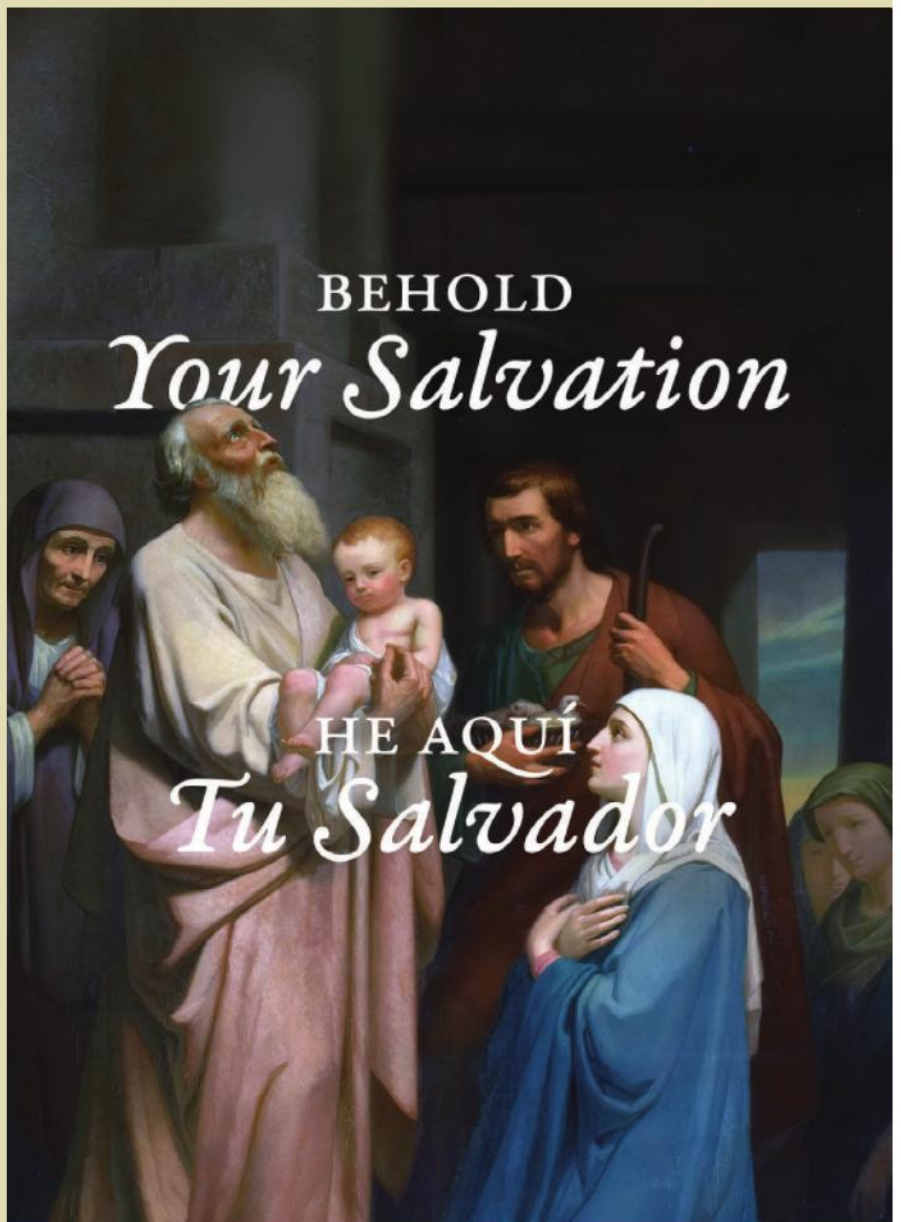

Dear Families and Friends of St. Francis Xavier Parish,

Dear Families and Friends of St. Francis Xavier Parish, I want to sincerely thank you for your support of our parish. Your support allows us to maintain our beautiful historic church, provide necessary resources for Catholic education, and nurture the spiritual development of all our church members.

As you know, in the summer of 2023 our parish was presented with the financial challenge of paying off our debt to the Diocese for our land on Table Rock Road. In addition, since July 2024, the start of this fiscal year, our collections have been short of our budget by over \$40,000.

Thankfully, the Diocese, demonstrating confidence in our parish, has presented us with an extraordinary opportunity. Through the Bishop's Debt Reduction Program, the diocese will match 100% of our contributions to our debt through June 30th. This opportunity was described in the recent mailing about our capital campaign, "Forward in Faith."

If we are solvent on June 30, 2025, and able continue to meet each month's expenses, the Diocese will allow us to continue in the Debt Reduction Program beyond June. This is a great opportunity for our parish.

As part of the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI) efforts, members of our parish have studied this determined that an intentional commitment of a simple 20% increase in weekly giving by parish families would give us the financial boost we need.

As an example, if you are currently giving \$20.00 each week, an increase to \$24.00 each week would greatly improve our financial health. We are also asking everyone to please give with regularity. Using electronic giving assures regularity and helps the parish because we are able to rely on those weekly contributions. There is a QR code on the forms in the pews to enable you to start electronic giving.

Our recent success in exceeding our goal for the Diocesan Annual Campaign (DAC) shows that we can reach our goal. 20% in 2025! We can do this!

Please complete one of the dual-purpose forms found in the pew to pledge an increase in offertory giving and to help us update our parish contact list by completing the contact information. Ushers will collect the pledge forms at the end of Mass.

Como saben, en el verano de 2023 nuestra parroquia se enfrentó al desafío financiero de saldar nuestra deuda con la Diócesis por nuestro terreno en Table Rock Road. Esta oportunidad se describió en el correo reciente sobre nuestra campaña de capital, "Adelante en la fe".

Si somos solventes el 30 de junio de 2025 y podemos seguir cubriendo los gastos de cada mes, la Diócesis nos permitirá continuar en el Programa de Reducción de Deuda más allá de junio. Esta es una gran oportunidad para nuestra parroquia.

Como parte de los esfuerzos del Instituto de Liderazgo Católico (CLI), los miembros de nuestra parroquia han estudiado esto y han determinado que un compromiso intencional de un simple aumento del 20% en las donaciones semanales por parte de las familias de la parroquia nos daría el impulso financiero que necesitamos.

Por ejemplo, si actualmente está donando \$20.00 por semana, un aumento a \$24.00 por semana mejoraría enormemente nuestra salud financiera. As we heard at the end of the Gospel today, “The child [Jesus] grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.” Luke 2:40 This is what we want for all of our children. Wisdom is a spiritual gift which enables one to know the purpose and plan of God. (CCC 1831) It helps us to see each day in the light of eternity. Wisdom deals with choices - this or that? The choice to build your house on sand or on rock. (see Matthew 7:21-27) Our character is revealed in the choices we make. It takes wisdom to make good choices. True wisdom lies in hearing and doing the will of God. The book of Proverbs describes wisdom as the supreme guide of man. 
